In the name of God Amen the Second day of November Anno  
 1654. I William Vincent of the Countrey of Virginia Merchant  
 being sick in body but of a good and perfect memory (God be pray'd  
 for the said) doe make this my last will & testament in maner  
 & forme following (Wiz) First I give & bequeath my soule into  
 the hands of Almighty God my Creator, hoping through the  
 merits of Jesus Christ my Saviour to obtayne  
 remission of my finnes, and my body to the earth from whence  
 it came to be decently buried, at the discretion of my Exors<sup>es</sup>,  
 and all my worldly goods I give as followeth. First I give and  
 bequeath to Elizabeth Vincent my deare & loving wife One  
 hundred pounds sterling if she be living to be paid to her  
 in England w<sup>th</sup> in Eight moneths next after my decease,  
 And in case she depart this life before the said day of paymt  
 then my will is that the said hundred pounds be equally  
 divided amongst my Sister Mrs Bridgett Edmond, and her  
 two daughters Katherine & Elizabeth Edmond, Item I give
